

<p>Dictated and corrected by me</p> <p> District Magistrate, Paschim Medinipur</p>	<p>Whereas, Election Commission of India vide press Note No. ECI/PN/23/2019 dated 10/03/2019 declared the scheduled for the General Election to Lok Sabha 2019 and the said election will be held on 12.05.2019 of All ACs except 232-Chandrakona (SC) AC in the District of Paschim Medinipur</p> <p>And</p> <p>Whereas, it appears from the Order that the campaign during the period of last 48 hours before the close of poll i.e. from 6.00 P.M., 10.05.2019 is prohibited. There will be a ban of campaigning for the last 48 hours before the scheduled Hour of Closure of Poll.</p> <p>And</p> <p>Whereas, there shall be restriction on presence of political functionaries, party workers, procession functionaries, campaign functionaries etc. who have been brought from outside the constituencies and who are not voters of the constituencies. Therefore, such persons should not continue to remain present in the constituency as their presence after the end of campaign period may undermine the atmosphere for free and fair poll.</p> <p>And</p> <p>Whereas, no loudspeakers fitted on vehicles of any kind or any other manner whatsoever shall be permitted to be used during the last 48 hours before the scheduled Hour of Closure of Poll in any polling area within the District of Paschim Medinipur except 232-Chandrakona (SC) AC.</p> <p>And</p> <p>Whereas, it appears from the Order that no person shall be allowed to either carry or use Cellular Phone, Cordless Phones, Wireless Sets etc. in the 100 meters perimeter of the polling stations or within the polling booth. Restrictions, However do not apply to the Officer-in-Charge of law and order and Security personnel put on duty near the Polling Booth and may be using any of such instruments in the course of discharge of their official duties, Similarly, these instructions do not apply to the Observers appointed by the Commission and the Officer-in-Charge of polling duties and persons drafted for polling duties in course of their official duties.</p> <p>And</p> <p>Whereas, no Arms should be carried inside the polling station, no unauthorized persons should be present inside the polling station at any time of during the poll.</p> <p>And</p> <p>Whereas, I am satisfied that there is every reason to believe that unknown miscreants and disgruntled persons may attempt to create disorder and trouble outside the aforesaid list of polling stations and thereby interfere in the smooth and fair conduct of polling process and also thereby may cause breach of peace of public tranquility. There is sufficient ground for proceeding for which immediate prevention is required.</p> <p>Therefore, I, Shri P. Mohangandhi, IAS, District Magistrate, Paschim Medinipur in exercise of the power conferred upon me U/S 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973, do hereby prohibit the followings in the entire area within the District of Paschim Medinipur except 232-Chandrakona (SC) AC with effect from 6.00 P.M. of 10.05.2019 (P-2 day of Poll) till end of Poll :</p> <p>a) Assembly of five or more persons excluding the persons who are voters in queue for the said Election, entitled to vote at the above stated polling stations within 100 meters of the building of the aforesaid institutions and for maintenance of law and order in and around the above mentioned premises.</p>	

- b) The use Microphone/Loudspeaker / Cellular Phone within 100 meters of the building excluding the personnel drafted for election duties.
- c) Carrying of fire arms, banners, lathis or such other articles in and around 100 meters of the venues excluding the security personnel drafted for election duties.
- d) Any such other activities which may disturb the process of polling / election.

Exigency of the situation does not allow me to serve the notice to aggrieved parties, if any, in the due time and the order passed ex-parte U/S 144(2) of Cr. P.C. 1973.

This order shall not apply to agencies / Officials of the Government involved in the enforcement of Law and Order, conduct of Election and the maintenance of essential services.

The Superintendent of Police, Paschim Medinipur is requested to serve the order to all concerned.
